The Onondaga County Health Department has a full time opening for a licensed Registered Nurse in the Bureau of Disease Control (BDC). The nurse will work closely with a team of clinical staff to provide screening, treatment, and patient education to patients primarily seen in the Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) clinic and also be a patient navigator to those seeking PrEP for HIV prevention. Nurses in the BDC take on many public health roles beyond clinical care, including case management, outreach, emergency response, and disease investigation. Typical hours are M-F 8:30 am – 4:30 pm. Applicants must possess a current NYS registered nursing license.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from a school of nursing approved by the State Education Department from a course approved as qualifying for Registered Professional Nurse.

SPECIAL NECESSARY REQUIREMENT:

Possession of a license and current registration to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse in New York State.
