The Onondaga County Department of Emergency Communications is seeking a qualified candidate for the position of Geographic Information Systems Specialist. The work involves responsibility for assisting in the planning, development and coordination of a Geographic Information System. An employee in this class uses GIS software to create, modify, analyze and display geographic data in order to meet the spatial data needs of the County. The GIS Specialist serves as a liaison with user departments and management.

Minimum Qualifications:

Open Competitive:

- A. Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a Baccalaureate Degree in Geography, Urban Planning, Environmental Science, Environmental Studies or a closely related field and one (1) year of work experience, or its part-time equivalent, using Geographic Information Systems (GIS) software; or,
- B. Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with a Baccalaureate degree in Geography, Urban Planning, Environmental Science, Environmental Studies or a closely related field, which included fifteen (15) credit hours in Geographic Information Systems; or,
- C. Five (5) years of paraprofessional or professional-level work experience, or its part-time equivalent, two (2) years of which must have been in a professional-level capacity involving the use of a full-featured Geographic Information System (GIS) software, including creating and modifying GIS data.

PROVISIONAL APPOINTMENT

Successful candidate will be appointed provisionally and must take the corresponding Civil Service exam, scheduled for a later date, and place high enough on the list to qualify for permanent appointment.
